



# Funeral Planning Components

<b>Potential element</b> <i>Any of these can be a part of the funeral but nothing is required</i>	<b>Thoughts or considerations</b> <i>Do you want this, do you want to determine who does it or what it comprises, or do you want to delegate to a specified person or leave it up those who will be responsible for the funeral</i>
a eulogy or eulogies	
a celebrant or speakers	
funeral director or funeral arranger (friend or family)	
music – recorded or live	
videos, photographs, options for streaming or recording	
body care including dress and personal affects	
use of shroud, coffin or casket	
body/organ donation	
coffinbearers or pallbearers	
location or venue – chapel, church or secular space	
death and funeral notices and obituaries	
a written order of service or funeral pamphlet	
readings, letters, prayers or quotes	
flowers and plants	
food or catering
